



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
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Rakhi Celebration



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
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Story Telling Competition






“THE ART OF COMMUNICATION IS THE LANGUAGE OF LEADERSHIP”



Communication is the process of understanding and sharing information where listening plays an important role. Intrapersonal or internal communication includes planning, problem-solving, self-talk, and evaluation of self and others. It is a continuous process that prepares the speaker to proceed in a clear and concise manner.
