- As per the new examination guidelines issued by CBSE, possession of mobile phone, smart watch, calculator, written material, books, notes etc. will be considered as an attempt to use unfair means and will result in strict action against the erring student. A student who resorts to any malpractice during the examination, will be awarded a ZERO for that particular exam. NO REQUEST will be entertained for leniency in such cases.
- A student must not write anything on the question paper except his/her name along with the roll number. No rough work or calculation should be done on the question paper. Any violation of this rule will result in appropriate disciplinary action.
- Only Blue ink should be used for the purpose of writing the exam. Student must carry appropriate stationery as they will not be permitted to borrow during the exam.
