
To explore the creative potential in the young minds of our students, an Art competition was held with the theme "Summer Season".

"THE SCIENCE OF TODAY IS THE TECHNOLOGY




The kids are setting a classic examples of utilising their time effectively by conducting Science experiments.




Encouraging such thoughts, our little munchkins of Sarvottam


