Encourage formulation of good habits

I strongly believe that if a child is not able to propose turn taking in a play scenario, then 'set the stage for him / her to learn about turn taking and giving to others. We can encourage such experiences where children take turns on toys and thus develop sharing. 'Vygotsky proposed that adults and peers provide assistance or scaffolding to help a child reach the level of independent performance.'

Crafted situations where the children need to understand the importance of waiting for their turn can have positive implications on the child's thought process. Therefore, the facilitator must carefully endorse turn taking in going to the toilet or washing their hands and so on. Research indicates that children's development is strongly influenced by the adult assistance. Concrete information is very crucial, children should be given concrete information about when their turn will be. For instance, when a child is waiting in front of the screen / slide he / she should be clearly made to understand that his / her position is five. This means that his turn will be after four kids.
